A Study of Youth's Peer Relationship and School Life

Dear Students:

We invite you to participate in a research study being conducted by investigators from The National Youth Policy Institute of Korea. The purpose of the study is to examine and compare the changing peer relationships among teenagers and their relationships with teachers from five different countries: South Korea, Japan, the United States, Germany, and Sweden..

If you agree to participate, we would like you to read the questions that deal with your relationship with your friends and your teachers and your attitudes about related matters. For each question, you are asked to choose appropriate answers that apply to you most closely.

While you are working on this questionnaire, we expect you to answer all the questions in order, without skipping any of the question items. Certain questions are for the ones who give particular answers to the previous questions; in that case, go to the designated questions according to the directions (Example: go to Q2). In the questions about your parents, you can answer about your guardian(s) if you don't have parents. Some questions ask you to check all the items that apply to you or to choose two answers depending upon your priority. In Other questions, you are asked to check one answer only. Therefore we suggest that you pay special attention to the number of the answers you are supposed to give.

It will take approximately 30 minutes to finish the whole questionnaire.

Your answers will be handled electronically and purely for statistical analysis. We will not collect your name or any identifying information about you, except your age and gender. It will not be possible for anyone to link you to your responses. Your anonymity is further assured by the fact that we will collect similar data from one hundred other student with the same age and gender as yours.
